COMPETITION TEAMS

This season will we be having 3 competition teams.

A new Mini team along with a Youth and Junior. All teams will be ALLSTAR to enable some of you to be able to crossover into different age groups. We also be having a tumbling session on a Monday evening for those that want to work on improving their skills, this will be open to all competition members. The tumble session will be split into skill levels so everyone is working on the appropriate level.

Our Mini team will be training on a Monday evening along side our cheer for fun class and the Youth and Junior teams will continue to be on a Tuesday evening. Competition members are expect to attend ALL sessions for their team along with any additional session whihe may occur during the season.

As Cheerleading is a **team sport**, it requires commitment from every single one of our members, but also from our parents.

Every member is an important part of the team and it is very difficult to train as a full team if people are missing from training, we can not replace someone in a stunt if the flyer or base is missing from training. It is even harder to replace member half way through the season if you decide to leave, you will be letting the rest of you team down, which results in having to re-choregraph the whole routine.

Therefore anyone who signs up for a team is expected to be a part of that team for the whole season, if you do leave during the season it could mean, the remaining team, may not be able to compete for the rest of the season, so please ensure that you are able to commit 100% to your team before signing up for the year.

If you leave part way through the season you will be liable for any competitions fees/spectator tickets which have already been submitted and will not be refundable.

FEES TRAINING & COMPETITION

Our Competition squads will all train for 1- 1.5 hours per week, and all squad members are expected to attend **all** sessions. Should you need to miss a session due to illness, school event, or family issue you must advise the club as soon as possible, please do not to leave it to the day of training unless it is a sudden illness. Attending a birthday party is not an excuse, we have to attend training for our birthdays

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU READ AND UNDERSTAND THE CLUBS RULES REGARDING ATTENDANCE BEFORE AGREEING TO BE PART OF THE COMPETITION SQUAD

Training sessions for **3 weeks prior to a Competition**, is classed as a **RED ZONE** you must attend all sessions for you team (which could be an additional session or a different day) if you miss a session without the coaches being informed before the start of the session, you will be removed from the team and WILL not compete.

We are changing the way we are going to collect fees, in previous years you have paid one fee and this has included your competition fees and training fees spread out over the season, however due to people leaving the club or deciding not to compete we have lost out on money which the club has already paid out.

When we enter a competition, once the entry has been placed we do not receive a refund if someone pulls out, infact we get charged an admin charge to withdraw athletes from our roaster and any spectator ticket ordered still have to be paid for out of club funds.

Therefore due to this we will be splitting the competition fees up from the training fees and a separate monthly payment will be collected, with competition fees being split over the first 4 months meaning ALL competition fees will be paid for by 31/01/24 and training fee will split as the full season.

We will also offer a 10% discount off all fees for siblings competing - if you are eligible for a discount you will receive an email confirming your fees

FEES AND PAYMENTS

We always try and keep fees to a minimum. The club is ran as a non profit club/voluntary basis and anything we charge is only to cover our costs. Unfortunately due to these costs increasing we have had to increase our fees slightly this season. We always try and get our entries in for the early bird prices to keep your costs as low as possible, this is why it is essential to keep to our payment deadlines.

As part of the competition squad as well as training and entry fees you will also have to purchase a competition uniform/shoes, spectator tickets for competitions and expenses like travel and hotel costs. Please take this it account when considering if you want to be part of our competition squad.

We will always try and accommodate anyone with payment issues to enable your child to compete, all we ask is to let us know before you fall behind with payments and we can try and sort out a payment plan





FEES AND PAYMENTS

Training Fees

All Training Fees are to be paid monthly over 11 months

These must be paid via your coacha account using either GoCardless or Stripe
(payments will be taken from your account on 10th of each month (September - July)

Membership

Everyone who joins the club will be asked to pay an annual membership fee, This will cost your insurance, music and licensing fees. This also includes a new season T-shirt for every member -

All Star Competition - £30 due by 1st September

Competition Entry Fees

These fees will now be set up for a separate payment spread out over 4 months. These payment will be taken of the 28th of each month from October - January

Spectator tickets

You will also have to be purchased for each competition, the costs vary depending on the Event producer from £10-£30. These must be ordered and paid for by the set date as advised. If we do not receive your ticket request and payments by the set date, we will not order you tickets and your could have to pay full on door price or miss out on purchasing as tickets do sell out early

Uniforms Costs

If you are new to the team you will purchase a uniform. The cost of the uniform is £85-£100 depending on team. A deposit of £50 must be made by 30th

September 2023 (balance paid 28th February 2024)

Mini - Top and Shorts / Youth and Junior - Leotard (top) and Skort

A hair is also included in the cost of your uniform and you will also need to purchase a pair of cheer shoes which can vary from around £40 upwards, (we will send out some links for shoes.

If you have grown out of your current uniform we may buy if back, and reduce the cost of your new uniform, however this will depend on the condition of the uniform

SETTING UP YOUR MEMBERSHIP AND PAYMENTS

Coacha

When you joined the club you would of been asked to create a COACHA account.

Please make sure you check your contact details are up to date.

Make sure you log into you account regularly as we will be using this more this coming season to send out important information (which will be posted on the Club notice board).

As well as sending out emails and payment links you will now be able to log into your account and book onto open classes which aren't set up on your regular fees.

You can also send a message from your Coacha account to inform us you will be absent, this will automatically update the register to let us know, as we don't always see your What's App Messages.

Our Club Shop will also be available through your Coacha account. This is a new feature which will be available soon. You will be able to purchase club merchandise directly through the app.

Payments and Memberships

Your payments will be taken via your Coacha account and all payments will be collected via GO CARDLESS or STRIPE. A subscription will be set up for your regular monthly fees which we run over 11 month. Don't forget you can log into your account to check what payments have been paid and what is due.
